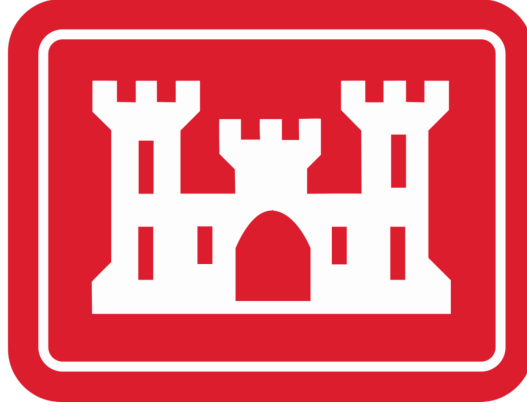
USACE Northwestern Division Commander Brig. Gen. Peter Helmlinger cordially invites all PNWA members to attend. No RSVP is required.
