Congress passes Continuing Resolution

The House of Representatives approved an extension of the current Continuing Resolution funding the federal government by a 221-212 vote yesterday, followed by the Senate, 69-28.

This measure maintains government funding at FY 21 levels through Feb. 18, 2022 or until FY22 appropriations are passed. President Biden is anticipated to sign the bill before midnight to avoid a lapse of funding and prevent a government shutdown.

PNWA will continue to advocate for our membership's priorities to be funded in the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' FY22 workplan, and will also focus on the development of the infrastructure package workplan.

PNWA is also following the Senate debate over the Build Back Better reconciliation package, which currently includes additional funding for the Port Infrastructure Development Program and funding for reducing vehicle emissions at ports.
