Columbia Snake River System

The nation's number one wheat export gateway and number two soybean export gateway is fed by a 365-mile, 14-foot draft inland barge system which stretches from Portland, OR to Lewiston, ID. The system exported over 51 million tons of cargo in 2020. It is also the west coast's number one wood and mineral bulks export gateway and a rising importer/exporter of vehicles. In all, approximately \$22 billion worth of cargo moves on the Columbia Snake River System each year.
